ROSE O'DONOVAN - JOURNALIST & MODERATOR

Rose O'Donovan has been Editor of AGRA FACTS since March 2010, having previously served as Deputy Editor on the agricultural publication for nearly three years. Prior to working as a journalist, she dealt with international relations on the EU satellite navigation programme at the Galileo Joint Undertaking. TIGRAN RICHTER - PRESIDENT EUROPATAT

Tigran Richter was born in 1963 in Leipzig (Germany) and finished his first degree in Agricultural Water Management in Moscow (Soviet Union). In 1993 he started to work for NORIKA, a German potato breeding company owned by a group of German potato processing companies. His entire professional career was dedicated to develop the international marketing of NORIKA potato varieties. He was appointed as managing director of NOREX, the export daughter company of NORIKA and is today co-managing director of NORIKA as well.

He has been representing NORIKA in several international associations such as Europatat and Euroseeds for many years. After having an active role in Europatat as chair of the Seed Commission for several terms, he was elected as President of Europatat in 2022.

PATRICK BAUDRY - FRENCH ASTRONAUT, UNESCO AMBASSADOR

Born in Cameroon, Patrick Baudry is a former fighter pilot in the French Air Force. He was also a Test Pilot in charge of Mirage 2000 prototype. He was a Cosmonaut with the Soviets in 1982 to fly on Soyuz-Saliout spacecrafts and he flew on the American space shuttle Discovery in 1985, taking with him the only bottle of wine which made a trip into Space.

He is a fervent defender of Europe, and he invested himself in the development of the European Space Shuttle project Hermesand would have been the chief Test Pilot in charge of this space ship.

Strongly involved in many projects for children education he created several schools as ACADIS and the first European Space Camp, and he is now a Goodwill Ambassador for UNESCO. He developed and sustains many educational achievments in Africa. Seing our own planet from Space changes our way of living and considering human beings. He considers today that the most important thing is not the Planet we are leaving to our children, but the children we are leaving to our Planet.



FLORENCE ROSSILLION - DIRECTOR GENERAL CNIPT

Florence Rossillion has been involved in the potato sector for more than 10 years. As Director General of the Interprofessional Committee for Fresh Potatoes in France, she manages relations between producers, traders, packers and retailers to establish action agreements in terms of agronomic research, economic studies, quality assessment potatoes, development of consumption and communication. She is also involved in lobbying for the potato sector in France and Europe. Florence Rossillion is graduated of the Paris Political Sciences Institute, certified as corporate director and has a master degree in management and human resources.



FRANCISCO MOYA - DIRECTOR GROUP VITALIS

Francisco Moya was born in 1964. With a Spanish origin, Francisco has lived and worked in France his entire life. He is currently the Managing Director of Vitalis Network, which was founded in 2017 and which he helped to create, and Vitexport.

As well as his professional commitment to the economic development of the companies in the Vitalis Group, he was also involved from a very early stage in professional associations and organisations in the potato sector. Currently, he's involved in FEDEPOM and the French interbranch CNIPT, and is an active member of EUROPATAT as well. At regional level, in the Nord Pas-de-Calais region, he has been in charge of public relations for the potato promotion association.

As recognition for his dedication to the potato sector, he was made a Knight of the French Order of Agricultural Merit in 2024.

FLORIMOND DEPREZ - HEAD OF POTATO BUSINESS UNIT OF GFD

Florimond is currently the head of the potato business unit of Groupe Florimond Desprez. GFD is a family-owned group specialised in breeding and seed marketing for beets and chicory, cereal and pulses, and potato. At GFD, Florimond is also managing the group's multi-crop subsidiaries in Morocco, Spain and Russia.

The two main entities of the potato business unit of GFD are Germicopa and Danespo. Respectively based in France and in Denmark, these breeding companies have a strong international focus and export two third of their seed production. Prior to heading the business unit, Florimond has been the general manager of Germicopa for 5 years.

Prior to joining the seed industry, Florimond worked for several years in investment banking as M&A advisor. His educational background is in agronomy with an engineering degree from Institut National Agronomique Paris-Grignon.



ALAIN BETANCOURT - SALES DIRECTOR PATATAS MELENDEZ

Alain Betancourt is Sales Director of Patatas Meléndez, company leader in the fresh potato market in Spain. Since 2020, he has driven a commercial transformation focused on innovation, quality and proximity to the consumer. With more than 20 years' experience in retail, much of it at Carrefour, he brings a strategic vision that has been key to the modernisation and growth of the company.



PHILIPPE QUENNEMET - PRESIDENT GIPT

DANIEL DESCHODT - EXECUTIVE VICE-PRESIDENT PORT DUNKERQUE

Daniel M. Deschodt is 55 years old and holds Franco-British nationality. He graduated from French International Management School in Lille, France and Lincoln University in San Francisco, USA. He started his career in an Asset – Based Intermodal Marketing Company as International Development Director based in Paris region.

Daniel moved to the stevedoring industry by joining the container terminal operator in Dunkirk, France in 2006, and joined the Port of Dunkerque April 2006. Since 2021, Daniel is now working with Port of Dunkirk Authority as Deputy CEO and CCO. DR ALAIN BAULARD - DIRECTOR OF RESEARCH INSERM, INSTITUT PASTEUR DE LILLE

Alain Baulard is Director of Research at INSERM. He holds a PhD in Molecular Biology from the University of Louvain and an HDR from the University of Lille. Recruited by INSERM as a Chargé de Recherche in 1997, he was promoted to Directeur de Recherche in 2009.

At the Institut Pasteur de Lille, he demonstrated that M. tuberculosis regulates its own sensitivity to proantibiotics through transcriptional regulators. Alain is also co-director of the High-throughput screening facility ARIADNE at Institut Pasteur de Lille. Since 2008, he is Invited Professor at the University of Louvain.



BERTA REDONDO BENITO - SECRETARY GENERAL EUROPATAT
